
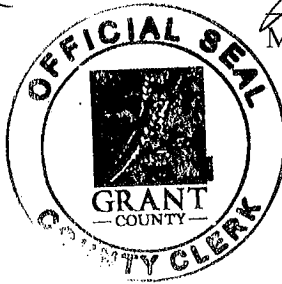



The Board of County Commissioners met in special session at 11:00 a.m. with Commissioner Long, Commissioner McHenry, and the County Clerk present. Commissioner Higgs was out of town. Bob Dale Passini, Economic Development Director; Jessica Akers, County Attorney; and Tom Fuhrmann, Landmark Appraisal, also attended the meeting. Media representatives were Lydia Kautz, Ulysses News. The meeting was called to discuss the county property located at 300 E. Maize.

Michael Snodgrass, Executive Director for Builders Development Corporation (BDC), told commissioners his organization was still interested in the property of the former care home located at 300 E. Maize. BDC would like to put 12 duplex units for senior housing rentals on this site. As a community housing and development organization they will seek funding from a combination of federal and state programs to bring high quality housing for seniors. Mr. Snodgrass is seeking an option to purchase on the land from the County. The options to sale property were discussed and it was the consensus of the commissioners to auction the property by bid. The county attorney was directed to start the legal process.

The commissioners adjourned at 11:50 a.m. to meet again in regular session September 3, 2013.
