



The Board of County Commissioners met in special session at 5:00 p.m. in the Golden Room of the Civic Center with all members and the County Clerk present. The meeting was called to discuss legal matters of litigation. Jessica Akers, County Attorney and Rita Gee, County Treasurer, also attended the meeting.

Linda McHenry made the motion to recess into executive session for 20 minutes with the County Attorney for consultation, which is deemed privileged in the attorney-client relationship. Carl Higgs seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. After 20 minutes the meeting continued in open session. Greg Wellbrock, County Appraiser and Cindy Wellbrock, Landmark Appraisal, joined the meeting. Linda McHenry made the motion to request John Frieden file an appeal for Judicial Review to the Kansas Court of Appeals, so they may reconsider the summary judgment made by the Court of Tax Appeals in favor of ExxonMobil/XTO in the matter of equalization. Carl Higgs seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

The commissioners adjourned at 5:30 p.m. to meet again in regular session March 18, 2014.
