GRANT COUNTY KS COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Grant County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Grant County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Grant County, Kansas.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Grant County, Kansas:

Where as, the State of Local Public Health Emergency in Grant County, Kansas declared on the 28th day of March, 2020, shall continue and remain in effect until 60 days unless terminated earlier.


Where as, the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Grant County, Kansas shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

Where as, any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local emergency disaster plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for 60 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
