Dear Residents of Grant County,

Governor Kelly's Executive Order 20-24 extends the "Stay at Home" Executive Order 20-16 to May 3rd, 2020. If you must do essential functions, practice social distancing. Stay at least six feet apart for less than 10 minutes. Practice hand washing. Avoid any out of county travel if possible.

Essential functions do include outdoor activities.

"Engaging in an outdoor activity" does not include:

- Business activities, sidewalk sales, festivals, fairs, or other outdoor assemblies or conventions
- Joyriding, cruising, or parades unless all occupants of the vehicle reside in the same residence and vehicles do not stop and congregate

Law Enforcement can cite people for disobeying executive orders from the Governor. This is a misdemeanor that could result in fines as well as jail time.

Grant County continues to have NO cases at this time. Thank you for your cooperation to stop the spread of COVID-19.
