As of 12:01am Monday May 4th 2020. The statewide "Safer at Home" order will be lifted, also at that time Phase 1 of the Plan to re-open Kansas (Executive Order 20-29) will take effect. This order eases many restrictions on individuals and some businesses. The basic outline is below. ### PHASE ONE

#### GATHERINGS

- Mass gatherings of no more than **10** individuals is allowed.

#### INDIVIDUALS

- Masks are strongly encouraged in public settings.
- Maintain 6 ft. social distance.

#### EMPLOYERS

- Telework is strongly encouraged when possible.
- Any employee exhibiting symptoms should be required to stay home.

#### TRAVEL

- Minimize or avoid nonessential travel.
- Follow KDHE guidelines for travel to high-risk areas.

#### ACTIVITIES NOT ALLOWED TO OPEN

- Community Centers
- Entertainment venues w/capacity 2,000+
- Fairs, festivals, parades & graduations
- Public swimming pools
- Organized sports facilities.
- Summer Camps

#### ESTABLISHMENTS NOT ALLOWED TO OPEN

- Bars & nightclubs excluding curbside & carry out
- Casinos (non-tribal)
- Indoor leisure spaces
- Fitness centers & gyms
- Personal service businesses w/close contact

#### EDUCATION, ACTIVITIES, & VENUES ALLOWED TO OPERATE

- Childcare facilities
- Libraries
