Outbreak information from 05/08/2020

There are 76 outbreaks with 2861 cases, 226 hospitalizations, and 101 deaths.

Long Term Care — 22 outbreaks, 540 cases, 139 hospitalizations, 85 deaths

Group Living — 3 outbreaks, 41 cases, 4 hospitalizations, 0 deaths

Gathering, Conference, Meeting — 8 outbreaks, 111 cases, 37 hospitalizations, 8 deaths

Correctional Facility — 3 outbreaks, 687 cases, 9 hospitalizations, 2 deaths

Health Care Facilities — 3 outbreaks, 22 cases, 0 hospitalizations, 0 deaths

Private Companies — 37 outbreaks, 1460 cases, 37 hospitalizations, 6 deaths.
