We have experienced a dramatic increase in positive COVID-19 cases over the last 10 days. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of protecting yourselves as well as your customers. We have had two businesses close for a period of time and one business have to alter their daily functions due to positive employees. The following information will help everyone to stay safe and well:

- ❖ **Keeping customers at least 6 feet apart at all times**
- ❖ **The use of masks by employees and customers is strongly encouraged. Masks have to cover both the mouth and nose to be effective.**
- ❖ **Keeping hands away from your eyes, nose and mouth**
- ❖ **Hand sanitizer available for customers and staff**
- ❖ **Increased hand washing for employees**
- ❖ **Increased sanitation measures throughout the day**
- ❖ **Employees must be sent home if they are sick to prevent the spread of any illnesses**
